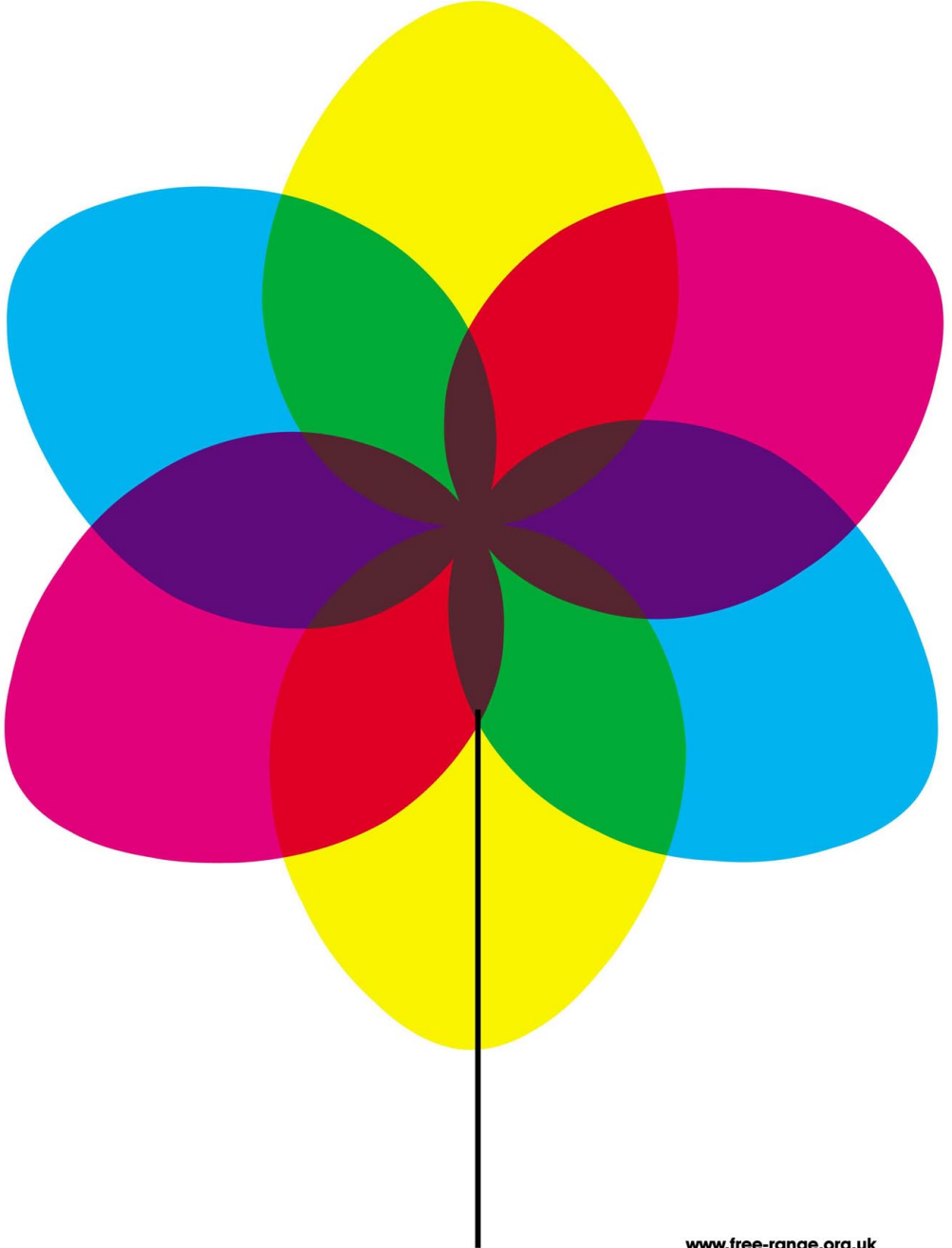

Free Range is one of the most exciting events in the British Arts calendar, bringing together the freshest crop of emerging talent from the country's premier art & design courses.

This is where the creative industries come face to face with the next Tracey Emin's, Rankin's and Pete Fowler's of this world.

Free Range 2005 is a festival of exhibitions hosted by the Old Truman Brewery on East London's famous Brick Lane, and is the largest of its kind in the UK. Taking place throughout the months of June and July, it is used by many leading art and design courses as their annual showcase.

Already more than 50 shows from various British universities and colleges such as Goldsmiths, Ravensbourne, Surrey, Middlesex and Reading have been confirmed for Free Range 2005. The exhibitions which cover a range of disciplines have been focused into four distinct categories – Art, Design, Photography and Interiors.

Free Range not only provides an outlet for exhibiting work to the public, but also a platform for exhibitors to engage with potential clients and employers. Now heading into its fifth year, it has become a recognised hunting ground for the creative industries to discover new talent, lending Free Range a real Kudos.

Free Range Project Manager, Tamsin O' Hanlon says, "Our aim is for the exhibiting graduates to feel they have climbed the next rung on their ladder to success by taking part in this programme, and we hope to expose them to as many industry players as we can."

A high quality brochure featuring editorials and a selection of work from each university and college is also produced, as well as the website www.free-range.org.uk which continues to show the works throughout the year.

The Old Truman Brewery and its sister locations in and around Brick Lane have a reputation for cutting-edge art, music, theatre and other cultural events, making it the ideal location for Free Range.

The Old Truman Brewery itself has been described by Time Out as 'the creative hub of the east end' and following ten years of sensitive regeneration and investment has become a destination point in its own right.

In the last year it has hosted amongst other events, the Hewlett Packard 'Hype' poster exhibition, a photography exhibition by the legendary Olivier Toscani, Carnesky's Ghost train, various exhibitions forming part of the London Design Festival, Cityscape, the RIBA Awards, and this April will see the Red Bull Art of Can exhibition.

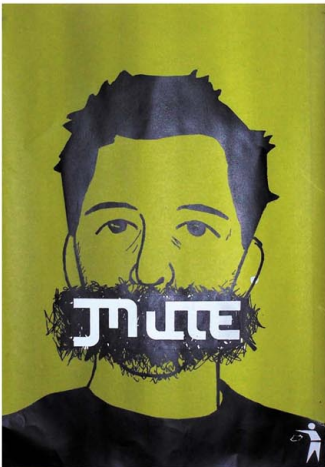
