

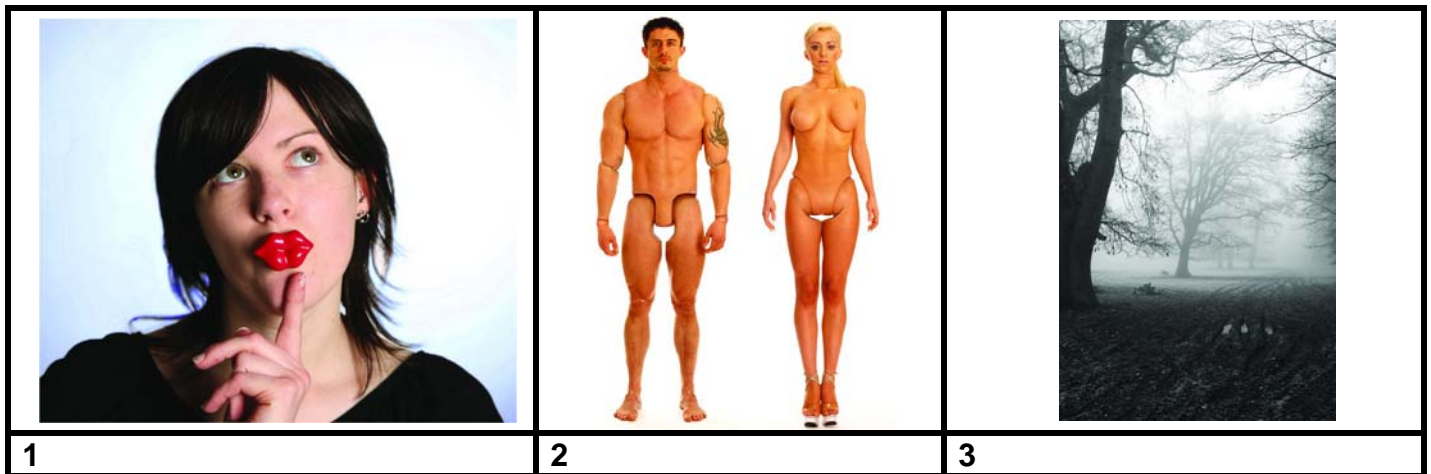

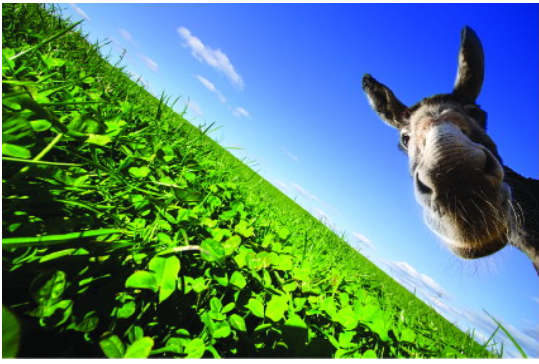

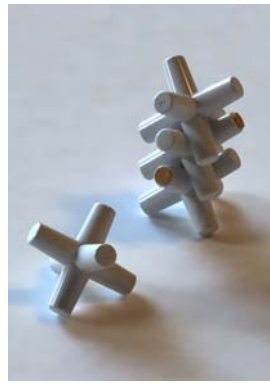
Want to find the next big name in art? Follow the example of the most savvy art collectors and browse Free Range during June and July 2007...
