3 There's Something About Airports by Alina Kaempf, who studies design at Goldsmiths, University of London.

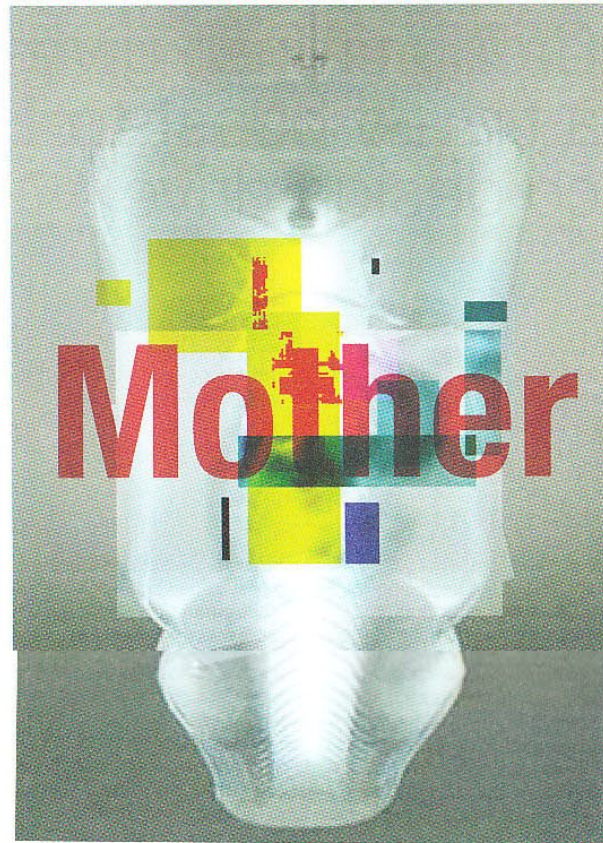
4 Work by Chloe Ehninger, who studies illustration at Plymouth University.
