It's a two-screen, 3D audio-visual installation showing a recording of a staged rehearsal of a script based on an updated adaptation of an early 3D silent movie, made in 1922, about a scientist attempting to transmit communications to Mars. What viewers made of the original movie in 1922 isn't known but what viewers will make of this is a subtle but perception-bending mix of time, memory, space and media. (HS) ▶ Jul 11.

The ground floor is a vibrant mix of more than 70 established and up-and-coming names while in the basement works by Phyllida Barlow, Karin Ruggaber and others use low-fi materials and a minimal aesthetic. The third instalment, Shahin Afrassiabi and Sam Basu's multi-screen text installation 'Data Wall', is as different again.
